

Rowena and David are experienced in taking service tours to Tanzania and have tours running for teachers as well as for students.

Tour groups Rowena and David have led previously, built classrooms in local schools, taught lessons, visited local communities and community organisations. Through the experience relationships and understanding was built. They also experienced the beauty of Northern Tanzania, through safaris and the excitement of climbing Mt Meru to watch the spectacular sunrise over Mt Kilimanjaro.

The groups visited and engaged with various organisations working with the impacts of poverty: orphanages, street childrens' work, schools involved in the promotion of the education of girls as well as an eye opening visit to the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda. For many it became a life changing experience.
